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Some accents I consider irritating in general in the place I live in right now are almost anything that is not as pure as the English spoken in the actual community when you need to sound more professional. Saying this I'm also including my accent. This is a hot topic to talk about as however you address the question you are going to get criticized and sometimes also considered as racist for making any claim regarding someone's "Sound House". During quarantine when we were isolated I had time in my hands and didn't know how to spend it. I used to play games where I would match with people from Asia and we used to play and talk together. They were trying their best to speak English in their own accents and sometimes when a word sounded funny in the accents they said it I used to imitate it and try to sound like them which is considered as disrespectful towards them even though it was meant in a joke kind of form. After going through the readings I do have some insight into my reaction and I think that I shouldn't judge them for the way they speak as how firstly I was part of them (and still am but my language has developed in a higher level since then) and how there is no perfect English. What you take into consideration is not the same as somebody else's. An idea I have is if we are to change to that type of English as how regarded in the book where people from your nation would consider you to white or to American I wouldn't want that as how knowing 2 languages is better than just 1
